Board of Director Reports Director Mendes mentioned that GSAs (7) within the Kings subbasin are working on an MOU to address the dispute resolution process, which will be overseen by local water industry experts. It was major accomplishment for these GSAs to come together and recognize the need for a plan to resolve disputes before they arise. This MOU will serve as a template for developing a formal coordination agreement for the subbasin.

11. Groundwater Sustainability Activities – Review for Possible Action

- 11.1 Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) Update See Item 11.2 for discussion.
- 11.2 DWR's Best Management Practices DWR held an online seminar January 19, 2018, introducing their fully integrated web portal for submitting SGMA related documents. KRE-GSA strongly desires for DWR to fast-track release of best management practices regarding water quality and depletion of interconnection surface waters as these items are major issues in addressing sustainability and the deadline for submitting a draft GSP is two years away. Technical Advisory Committee is waiting for a BMP on the depletion of interconnected streams and water quality.
- 11.3 Proposition 26 Report update and review Ms. Alison Lechowicz from Lechowicz + Tseng Municipal Consultants gave a presentation covering some of the main points within the Groundwater Fee Study report. She mentioned that the GSA will have both a nominal fee and groundwater pumping fee to address areas that impact the aquifer differently, discussed the methodology used to develop a rate structure, explained how water budgets utilized crop surveys from 2014 and 2016 to estimate groundwater pumping, and identified the requirements (outlined in the fee report) for providing metered well data in lieu of estimated groundwater pumping values. DWR has two years to review and comment on a GSP; however, the clock does not start until all GSPs within a subbasin are sent to DWR.
