What is the future of groundwater management?

Kings River East GSA is the Groundwater Sustainability Agency in your area leading the way to sustainably manage groundwater. The Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) signed in 2014, is an unfunded State law requiring groundwater subbasins be sustainable by 2040. The Kings River East GSA was formed to implement the law and will focus on solutions to capture additional water supply to offset groundwater use, improve water quality, and address other SGMA issues. In the coming years, additional projects and actions will be implemented to sustain our groundwater resource.

The Kings River East GSA's priority is to continue implementation of projects to capture surface water supply for various beneficial uses and to improve groundwater quality. This is included in the Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP), the roadmap to achieve a sustainable groundwater supply.
